



## EAST FREMANTLE DISTRICT SPECIFIC COMPETITION RULES- 2011 Season

1. All match documents are to be delivered to the District Registrar **no later** than the **Monday 12 noon** following the weekend. The game results from all games are to be input into the Sporting Pulse online results website by club registrar or team manager no later than **Sunday evening 8.00pm**. All results / ladders will be subject to confirmation on receipt of paperwork. Note that Year 4's – Year 6's must be entered as 1 point draws.
2. Where an umpires report has been made in 13's – 17's
  - i. The club registrar or nominated P&D representative **must** deliver to the District Registrar the original Umpires Report form and all match documents from that game **no later than 7:00 pm Sunday**
  - ii. All other match documents are required to be delivered to District Registrar **no later than 12 Noon the Monday** after the weekend.
3. Team Managers are required to have ALL paperwork signed by umpires BEFORE the game commences. Any player arriving AFTER the game commences may be added to the team sheet at quarter time only. Any addition to the previously signed team sheet MUST be noted by the umpires.  
*(Note: this competition rule commenced 2008 season and overrides By Law 17.8)*
4. **LATE BIRTHDAY INTERPRETATION**
  - **For the 2011 season only, the requirements of clause 11.2.3 for a proven history of playing down will be satisfied if the player has played down for a minimum of two years between 13's and 16's (non medical).**
  - **The granting of any such request shall apply only for the 2011 season and subject to review by the JCC Executive during the course of the season.**
  - **“A player who chooses to register under the provisions of by-laws 11.1 & 11.2 (ie “play down”), requires prior written permission from the JCC, to play in any age group other than the age group he has registered with using these provisions.”**
  - E.g. A 15 year old uses his late birthday to play in the 14s. He now can only play in the 14s and needs prior written approval of the JCC to play 15s.
  - Penalty will be **“Playing an ineligible player” ie FORFEIT**  
*(Note: this competition rule commenced 2008 season)*
5. **COLTS PLAYERS** wishing to return to play community football must complete and lodge the appropriate signed form with the umpires PRIOR to the match and such form MUST be lodged with official paperwork handed to the District Registrar. During the home and away games EFDADC will be enforcing the directive which is a part of the player management coming in from the colts (WAFL), where the players who play in excess of half a game are not allowed to play at club level on the same weekend.  
All clubs are required to provide, prior to the commencement of the season, to the District Registrar a list of colts players. This list is to be kept updated during the season. Should a registered colts player be required to play in the EFDADC competition then the player MUST complete the correct Permission Form (provided to all clubs) signed by their WAFL Football Manager/Official. This form MUST be submitted with match paperwork.  
During the finals this rule is suspended and players who have qualified at club level to play may do so subject to the approval of their WAFL Football Manager/Official.  
**Penalty applies as per playing an ineligible player should any team ignore this. Penalty is FORFEIT of match.**  
*(Note: this competition rule amended for the 2011 season)*

6. **BEANGE RULE**

The following Competition Rule was introduced at the commencement of the 2006 season.

The intent of this rule is to put in place an easily administered mechanism to support the competitions policy of equal playing time. It does this by minimising the situation of stronger players from age groups above and below playing to the exclusion of players of lesser ability but permanent members of that side. With present checks in place being the identification of players on the match sheets it requires no further administration but gives a definitive outcome

ALL Registrars, Team Managers and Coaches should make themselves familiar with this ruling. **NO EXCUSES.**

**COMPETITION RULE**

relating to restrictions on number of players allowed to “play-up” (1 year only & based on players Date of Birth) in order to boost player numbers:

That a side that has available twenty one (21) players registered with that team cannot then include in that side for that fixture the following:

Players from a younger age group.

Players of equal age but registered for another team within the same club

Players whom under the late birthday ruling qualify to play down but are registered with the older age group.

Players whom do not qualify as detailed under other By Laws or Competition Rules

Should a team have available less than twenty one (21) players registered with that team only then can they include up to the maximum of twenty one (21) the following players:

Players registered from a younger age group but not to the contravention of By Law 9.3

Agreed to by all Club Presidents prior to commencement of Season 2006.

**7. By Law 25 Game Day Player Even Up**

i. “If a side can only field between 14 and 17 players the opposition coach should offer surplus players to the lesser numbered team. Should the lesser numbered team coach refuse the offer both teams must play with the same amount of players on the field”

***(This Competition Rule ammended 2011 season and overrides By Laws 25.2.4 and 25.2.7)***

ii. “Where players are lent to another team, their names must be entered on the team list of that team and their original team name shall be shown in brackets beside their names. EVEN UP RULE APPLIED is to be noted on team sheet.
